

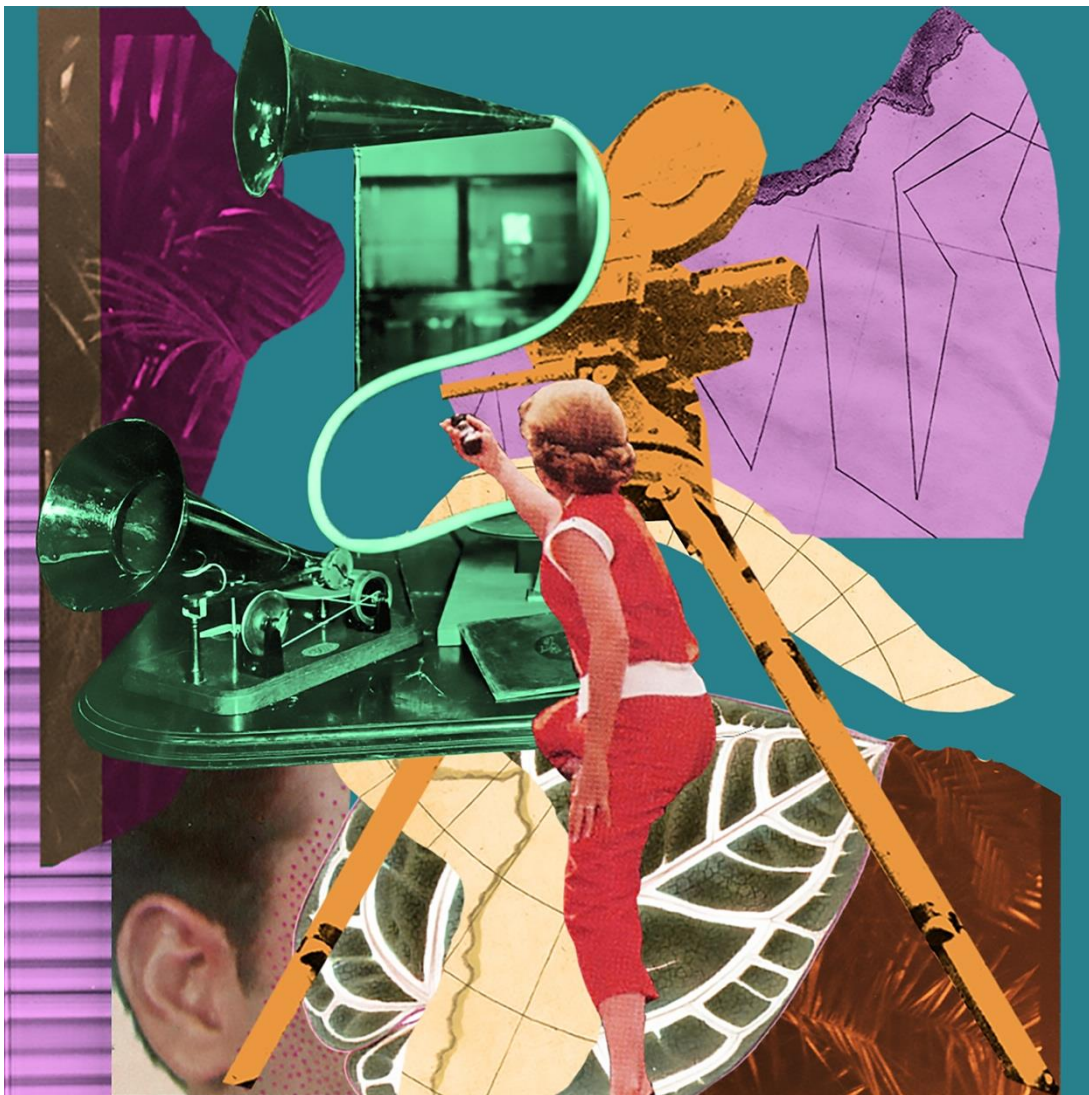

The emergence of sound film gave new impetus to entertainment circuits around the world, redesigning new cultural cartographies that forged images of spaces, nations and regions.

Film played a key role in the utopia of being able to see it all with our eyes. By the late 1920s and early 30s, the emergence of sound and, therefore, music and words with these images, gave film a more complex role in the configuration of national and regional cultural identities in incipient mass markets. The articulation of the domestic-global duality took on new dimensions in the outlining of identity images in each historic context.

This CFP promotes the study and research of cultural identities articulated in cinema and their relationship with other contemporary entertainment circuits, such as musical theater, radio or record industries. It also establishes an interdisciplinary framework that bridges Musicology, Film Studies, Cultural Studies, Sociology and Screen Studies.

The main topics of study include:

- Nationalism, borders and music cinema
- Stars and cultural industries
- Performance, corporality and gender studies
- Affects and sound atmospheres
- Cinema and propaganda
- Cartoon cinema and its sonorities
- Music in new devices for consuming cinema
